ATV Trail Update

ATV clubs are working on a new ATV map for the 2018-19 seasons. The map should be available May 1, 2018.

Wolf River Crossing-Langlade Bridge Project: There is a proposed ATV route to connect the motorized portion of the Wolf River State Trail to Oconto County. The White Lake ATV Club is working with an ATV club from Oconto County. They are also looking to cross the DNR fisheries property for this route. The ATV clubs are looking to apply for a grant to cross the Wolf River and they need it to be sponsored by a local unit of government and are looking for Langlade County Forestry Department to be that unit.

Langlade County Augustyn Springs-Bass Lake Trail: Langlade County developed 7.9 miles of new ATV/UTV off road trail known as the Augustyn Springs-Bass Lake Trail. An additional 2/3 miles of "troute" (no state funding) will also be utilized as trail connectors. The new trail/troute system would connect the Augustyn Springs ATV system to the Bass Lake-Summit Lake area and ultimately, the Parrish Highland ATV system. The new segment will be open this spring.

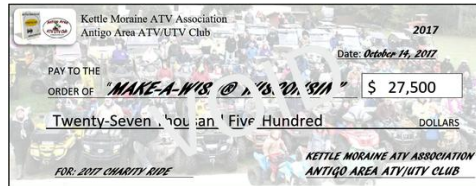
