## New Trail

Thanks to the efforts of our club officers and followers, the City of Antigo Common Council and Townships of Antigo and Neva approved a new trail. The meetings were attended last summer (2014) requesting permission for an ATV/UTV trail out of Antigo. After much discussion and deliberation, the City and Townships granted a “one year trial basis” for a trail. The use of the former railroad grade corridor from the intersection of Amron Avenue and Saratoga Street (across from Karl’s Transport) north to County Road “N” (near Rick’s 45 Roadhouse) as an ATV trail to connect the City of Antigo to the existing Langlade County trail systems. This will be in effect for the 2015 riding season.

Special thanks go out to Jack Anderson, Pete Pennington, and Charlie Huhn for their many hours of labor in clearing trees and brush, and removing railroad ties to make room for this trail north out of Antigo.

# INAUGURATION TRAIL RIDE

SATURDAY, MAY 9<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. is the date of our Inauguration Trail Ride. We invite all ATV/UTV riders and their machines to meet at Peaceful Valley Park (located at 420 Field Street, Antigo). We will form a ride and, with the City of Antigo police escort, we will ride our machines through the city towards the start of our newly formed trail on Amron Avenue (across from Karl's).

The journey will take us on the new 1.3 mile trail to County Road "N", cross "N", and continue 1.0 mile on the new trail to Angle Road. Turning left on Angle Road, the ride will continue toward the Parrish Highlanders ATV/UTV Clubhouse where a light lunch and beverages will be served. A "**word of caution**": The police escort only goes to the start of the new trail; there will be no riding back through the city to load your machines. You are encouraged to park your trailers at the Antigo Super 8, FS Fast Stop, Holiday Inn Express, or BP Travel Center. All sites are located on Highway 45 North. It is advised that you move your trailers to one of these sites after unloading your machines at the starting point at Peaceful Valley.



**FUN NIGHT:** In conjunction with our Inaugural Trail Ride, Antigo First, Inc. is sponsoring a fundraiser on Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup> at the Edison Club Event Center located at 623 Edison Street in Antigo. There will be a dinner and comedy show for \$50/person. Bob Zany and Mike Mercury will provide the entertainment and there will be an elaborate meal as well. The same duo will be available for a comedy act only on Saturday, May 9<sup>th</sup>. The cost for the comedy act is \$20 in advance, or \$25 at the door.
